## Year 7 catch- up data 2020

This data is based on support and intervention given between September 2019 to 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020

## **Numeracy catch-up**

Based on KS2 results 29 pupils were identified as requiring additional support and below national expectations in Maths, <99.

Each pupil received 25 hours of intensive support delivered by a partner organisation. Pupils responded well to the provision and gained skills and the foundation to excel in Maths throughout the year.

Additional interventions such as specialist classroom support (daily) and small group work (weekly) were provided to aid pupils requiring additional help.

Interventions were allocated according to progress based on half termly data drops.

On-line learning such as Maths Watch aided pupils during lockdown.

Data generated prior to lockdown (March 2020) indicated that:

79% of pupils exceeded their target, achieving a level 1+ or above 7% of pupils met their target, achieving a level 1 14% of pupils are working below target

Average spend per pupil: £379

## Literacy Catch up

Based on KS2 results 52 pupils were identified as requiring additional support and working below national expectations i <99.

Each pupil received 25 hours of intensive support delivered by a partner organisation. Pupils responded well to the provision and gained skills and the foundation to excel in English throughout the year.

Additional provisions such as Accelerated Reader, Read with Me, specialist classroom support (daily) and small group work (weekly) were provided to aid pupils requiring additional help.

Interventions were allocated according to progress based on half termly data drops.

Data generated prior to lockdown (March 2020) indicated that:

11% of pupils exceeded their target, achieving a level 1+ or above

36% of pupils met their target, achieving a level 1 53%% of pupils are working below target

As of July 2020, 28 pupils are still deemed to be below National expectations in literacy. Interventions have been reviewed and allocated in year 8. A full time Literacy tutor has been appointed by the school to provide frequent and specific intervention.
